### **So how do you participate in our new reward's system and have your fundraising fee returned?**

To keep our club operating takes a lot of volunteer effort and a lot of fundraising effort. Mowing lawns, fixing boats, and general building maintenance are just a few areas that volunteers are always needed. Along with helping out around the club, supporting our fundraising events either by attending or helping is another way to volunteer. To have your fundraising fee (\$100) returned to you, you simply need to participate in 10 "volunteer roles" and accumulate 10 pts. Below are some ways you can volunteer and collect volunteer points:

- **Drive Official Boats or be in Safety Boats at Regattas (all summer)**  
Full day volunteering – 2 pt  
Half day volunteering – 1 pt  
Sackawa is required to provide safety boat volunteers on the following dates:  
(May 18, 19, 20 / June 10 / July 10 (3 req'd) & 29 / Aug 5, 23 / Oct 6)
- **Annual washer toss (June 2/18)**  
Fence set up and/or tear down (requires minimum 2 people each)  
Bartender  
Run the bbq (requires 2 people)  
Game set up (requires minimum 2 people)  
Game tear down (requires minimum 2 people)
- **Auction (August 11/18)**  
Donation of auction item(s) valued > \$50.00 - 1pt  
Paying attendee - 1 pt per family  
Selling tickets - 1 pt per every 5 sold (not including family unit)  
Auction set up (requires minimum 2 people)  
Auctioneer  
"Vanna White" at auction to show items and be spotters (requires minimum 2 people)
- **Around the Club**  
Repair of Sackawa info sign  
Sun shelter roof repair  
Organize and operate Atom regatta bbq (held at Sackawa, requires 2 people)  
Lawn mowing (starting in May we will have a sign-up list, we have a drive-on mower!)  
Snow removal  
Helping put out docks  
Helping bring in docks  
Boat repair  
Motor maintenance for motorboats
- Shifts at any fundraising bbqs we may run at local regattas

And any other role that assist us in operating Sackawa!
